Here are some key safety points the staff thought might be helpful to you:

- After signing in on the green sheet in the classroom, **all visitors must wear a visitor name card.** Please make sure you leave the name card when you sign out on the green sheet.
- All aides are CPR and First Aide trained and certified.
- Certified classroom

teachers are required to provide any medications to students.

- Please do not park in the fire lane in the front of the school.
- Please drive slowly on Midnight Sun Circle.
- Please stay off your cell phones in the pick up and drop off lines.
- Doors remain locked after the morning drop off. Late arriving students or parents who come during the day need to come to the child's classroom door. This helps to assure that the doors are opened for people we know.
- Only staff are to open doors at school. If a parent sees someone at a door please get a staff member.
