## Parent Volunteer Confidentiality Agreement

Per our January APC meeting, the staff has been developing a Parent Volunteer Confidentiality Agreement. This form must be signed and returned to the school prior to any parent volunteering in the school. The form is attached to today's newsletter and should be returned to your child's classroom teacher. One form should be on file for each parent volunteer in the family.

## Eligibility

Per School District policy: students wishing to participate in a school activity must be in attendance all day on the day of the event or activity. If the activity takes place on the weekend, the student must be in attendance for the full day on Friday and Monday.

## Morning Drop-Off

This is a reminder that if you need to park in the morning and bring your children into the school, you need to park on one of the sides of the school and walk with your children on the sidewalk. We put out the cones in the morning to try to remind people to not park in the front, but we still have people parking in the front and walking children through the moving traffic.
