Over Volunteering

Aims Web Testing

All students in grades K-3 will be screened for Reading through Aims Web testing on September 6 and 8. This test takes about 15 minutes and is given one-on-one by a trained test administrator.

Vision and Hearing Screenings

Our volunteer nurses will begin Vision and Hearing screenings next week for all students. It takes us several weeks to get through everyone. If a concern arises on one of the screenings, you will receive a referral letter.
