Absences

A reminder: you need to call your child's teacher and tell him/her the reason for any absence. The office does not enter absences codes in our school. This is an important communication procedure. It is very helpful if you let the teacher know as soon as possible about an absence.

Participation

Per School District Policy: for an activity that occurs on a weekend, the student must be in school for the FULL day on Friday to participate in the activity.

This means: to participate in the Fun Run students must be in school all day on Friday.

For activities and school events that occur on a school day, the student must be in school for the full school day to participate.

Box Tops

We collect Box Tops for Education. The funds from these go to each classroom. Please make sure the Box Tops are trimmed before you send them in to your child's class.

Cleaning

Every family has to clean once in every four-week rotation for each of your children's classrooms. Missed cleaning is \$30 per time, if the cleaning is not made up within two weeks of the cleaning date.

Entering the School After 8:55
