State Mandated PEAKS Testing

Students in grades three through eight will be taking the state mandated PEAKS tests April 3-5. This testing is a part of the Federal law created by President George W. Bush with the No Child Left Behind in 2002.

As a charter school, Midnight Sun has a higher stake in these tests than most schools. The test results are used to determine our eligibility to renew our charter. In addition, the test data helps us to improve the program we offer to your children to assure they are ready for high school.

We receive a score as a school both for our student's academic scores and for participation. We are required to have 95% participation to be considered for an acceptable rating.

Our students regularly out score other students in the District and State! We love to be able to celebrate your amazing children!
